GAO found that these changes generally began with a corporate decision to pursue a more strategic approach to acquiring services—from developing a better picture of what the company was actually spending on services to developing new ways of doing business. The Defense Department (DOD), the governments largest purchaser of services, already has some elements in place that are essential to such a strategic approach, such as a commitment by top management to adopting best practices. However, DOD has yet to conduct a comprehensive analysis of its spending on services or thoroughly assess its current structure, processes, and roles. DODs size, the range and complexity of the services that it acquires, the capacity of its information and financial systems, and the unique requirements of the federal government are among the factors that DOD will need to consider as it tailors a strategic approach to its diverse needs.
