The Ho is an indigenous people of India where they are also categorized as a Scheduled Tribe. The study tries to depict how ethnicity, traced through various ritual actions related to the annual festivals and life cycle of the Ho ethnic group, provided the community with survival strategy to cope with their problems in adaptation to an industrial environment.
