Below is a list of the prizewinners during the period 1996-2000 with a description of the works which they won the prizes for: R.F. Curl, Jr., H.W. Kroto and R.E. Smalley (1996) - for their discovery of fullerenes; P.D. Boyer and J.E. Walker (1997) - for their elucidation of the enzymatic mechanism underlying the synthesis of adenosine triphosphate (ATP); J.C. Skou (1997) - for the first discovery of an ion-transporting enzyme, Na⁺, K⁺-ATPase; W. Kohn (1998) - for his development of the density-functional theory; J.A. Pople (1998) - for his development...
