The committee of arrangements, consisting of Gen. James Irish, Col. Samuel Stephenson, Hon. Toppan Robie, Joseph M. Gerrish, Esq., and Caleb Hodsdon, Esq., were among the most prominent, as well as most active and efficient citizens of their day; and the names of most of them are intimately connected with the history and prosperity of the town.
