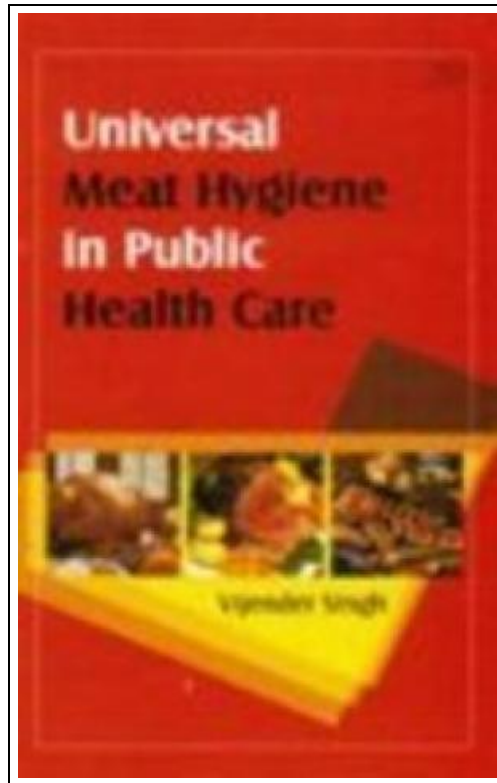

Our knowledge base as to how dangerous mammals agree to live in human dominated landscape is very scanty because the subtle nuances that help them to manage their lives in such terrains without becoming a problem have yet not been studied by any ethologist.
