An environmental index might range, for example, from 0 (representing low risk of exposure) to 100 (representing a high exposure risk). Or, instead of a health risk, one or more environmental conditions might be represented (e. g. , dissolved oxygen levels as one indication of water quality). The development of an index often also involves establishing weighting factors (i. e. , giving the more important variables more weight than less important variables) as well as an equation for combining all the relevant data values into the index scale.
