It is common near Darjiling, where the wood is largely used for building purposes, chiefly for native houses. This is the noted sum tree of Assam, on the leaves of which the Muga silk-worm (*Anthercea Assama*) feeds. Maize. Set Zea Mays. Malachra capitata. A fibre plant newly introduced into India. The sample sent to Am-Fibre, sterdam was from the Bhadgaon Farm, Bombay. Malancha. (Unidentified.) A grass found in the rice-fields of Bengal; used as...
