Much that was done was ill advised, but in hindsight, as lan Buruma shows us, these efforts were in fact relatively enlightened, humane, and effective. A poignant grace note throughout this history is Buruma s own father s story. Seized by the Nazis during the occupation of Holland, he spent much of the war in Berlin as a laborer, and by war s end was literally hiding in the rubble of a flattened city, having barely managed to survive starvation rations, Allied bombing, and Soviet shock troops when...
