Originally published in the First Folio of 1623, where it was listed as a comedy, the play s first recorded performance occurred in 1604. The play s main themes include justice, mortality and mercy in Vienna, and the dichotomy between corruption and purity: some rise by sin, and some by virtue fall. Mercy and virtue predominate, since the play does not end tragically. Measure for Measure is often called one of Shakespeare s problem plays. It was, and continues to be, classified as comedy, though its tone and setting defy those expectations. Vincentio, the Duke of Vienna, makes it known that he intends to leave the city on a diplomatic mission. He leaves the government in the hands of a strict judge, Angelo. In the next scene, we find a group of soldiers on a Vienna street, expressing their hopes, in irreverent banter, that a war with Hungary is afoot, and that they will be able to...
