Where the number of children is so large, they cannot be conveniently accommodated in the place of worship, the whole of the forenoon may be devoted to the purposes of tuition and religious instruction in the School room; or a certain number of classes taken every Sunday morning in rotation. It appears desirable that each child should attend public worship at least once every Lord s Day. Where there is no public service in the after noon, the whole of that time may be employed in the work of tuition.
