In other words, the captor, if duly commissioned, had a right, under the general principle, to carry his prize into the port of any nation at peace with France, without any other risk than being ordered to depart. The chief, and perhaps the only difficulty between Spain and the United States, in relation to these captures, was confined to a single fact, to wit: Whether France had embraced them in the satisfaction she made to the United States in the convention of 1800. If she had, Spain contended there could be no claim on her; if she had not, Spain admitted her liability. The United States took the position that France had, in that convention, made satisfaction only for the illegal or irregular acts committed in her own...
