Belgian Astronomical Publications. --An interesting evidence of the industry and devotion of Belgian astronomers during the occupation of their country by the Germans is the recent appearance of the Annuaire de lObservatoire Royal de Belgique for the years 1915, 1916, 1917 and 1918. The prefaces of the last three volumes are all dated Nov nber 11th, 1918, the day of the armistice. It appears that the books were printed in Brussels year by year without the knowledge of the Germans, but were not issued because they would have had to be submitted to the enemy censor. Much current information had to be omitted from the volumes later than 1916 for the reason that astronomical publications did not reach Belgium during the war. The work of the observatory was carried on during the war by M. Stronbant, chief astronomer,...
