There is in the show a great deal of paint well laid on; there are many examples of clever draughtsmanship, there is an appreciable amount of agreeably managed colour arrangement; the evidences of the efficiency of the modern art school teaching are plentiful and, in their way, convincing. Yet, with all this, the exhibition is by no means impressive as an art display. It lacks obviously just that note of inspiration and of personal intention which is necessary to make it interesting; it lacks spirit and vitality, and it suffers seriously from paucity of ideas. Most of the contributors seem to have forgotten that to draw well and to put paint cleverly upon canvas cannot be accepted as the sole duty of...



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
