Existing books on Labour Laws are either too technical or too cumbersome with plethora of case laws or too brief and too sketchy that they hardly convey anything. The result is that students get confused and develop dislike for the subject. Considering the above difficulties, this book has been written in simple and non-legal language. First few chapters provide the right ambience and correct background to make the students understand the need of different labour laws. The concluding chapter deals with the need for review, revision of existing laws and reinvention of new laws to meet the future requirements. The book contains a detailed background about each law explaining the genesis for the enactment of that law. The emphasis is more on to outline the salient features in detail, giving practical examples to make the concepts clear and to convey the fundamentals rather than giving minute details. Taking advantage from his wide experience as practicing manager and teacher of labour laws, the author has added some topics which are not laws per se but their knowledge and understanding is much more important than the proper laws.
