

It has been my fortune to know this life pretty intimately for sixteen years. From 1872 to 1878 I was a student at Harvard; since 1880 I have been instructor there. Beginning work as a teacher so soon after I had ceased work as a pupil, I found myself in sympathy with the students to a degree perhaps unusual; and the nature of my work has kept me in close relation with them ever since. In the first place, the subject I have been teaching--English Composition--is still a part of the course prescribed to every undergraduate; in the second, I have been accustomed for five years to require from every pupil in my elective course what I call daily themes. These are in effect journals: each student writes a note of what each day...
