Wicca is the Old English word for witch; witches (usually women, but also men) were people who used charms, spells, and herbs in rituals of healing, and as aids in childbirth, matchmaking and spiritual guidance (Hubbard 173). The term was adopted by Gerald Gardner as a general name for the witchcraft religion he had helped revive in the 1930s, and is now used mainly in that sense, being pronounced wickah. A member...
