Excerpt from Official Grades of the Public Streets of the City and County of San Francisco: Comprising All Grades Established to March 20, 1909 Prior to the year 1853, the grades of streets were fixed and determined from time to time on the ordering of street improvements, when necessary to afford business facilities. In the early part of that year, proceedings were inaugurated in the Common Council for the establishment of grades, which resulted in the employment of Messrs. Milo Hoadley and William P. Humphreys, in May, 1853, to do and perform all the work and labor necessary to the establishment of suitable, proper and permanent grades for the streets of the City of San Francisco. These gentlemen presented reports in June and July, 1853, recommending the grades to be established on all the streets, which grades were established by the Common Council by Ordinances Nos. 350 and 425. In 1854 the Common Council adopted a Resolution which recited that sufficient manifestations of disapprobation on the part of the people had appeared in relation to the City grades...
