

Some years ago I noticed this result in a paper published in the Medical Gazette, in which I first pointed out the serious error of regarding the green feculent discharges so often noticed in infancy as owing their colour to an excess of bile, tracing their title to altered blood, and shewing that this condition should be regarded as a form of melaina, and the too popular treatment by mercurials repudiated. If bile be agitated with animal charcoal and filtered, the colouring matter is removed, and by careful evaporation the white lustrous powder I now shew you is obtained; this decolourised bile may, after removing the little fat it contains, be obtained in a crystalline form. The specimen I now shew you is in fact bile, freed from mucus, fat, and pigment, and in this state is a bilate of soda. The organic element or bilic acid differs somewhat in different animals, as has been more especially shewn by the interesting researches of Dr. Kemp. It is remarkable, for always with the exception of the bile of the pig, containing a considerable quantity of sulphur. In the ox, the decolourised bile or bilate of soda consists of C48 H43 N, O S1 Na O. The following table shews the per-centage properties of sulphur present in the bile of different animals, chiefly from the researches of M. Bensch. The bile freed from its pigment does not present the play of colours...
