In his Remarks on the Death of Mr. Webster before the Suffolk Bar, on October 2Sth, 1852 - an eulogy only less graceful and memorable than his more elaborate discourse delivered before the alumni of Dartmouth College the following summer - Rufus Choate paid this tribute to the literary quality of Webster s speeches: All that he has left, or the larger portion of all, is the record of spoken words. His works, as already collected, extend to many volumes - a library of reason and eloquence, as Gibbon has said of Cicero s - but they are volumes of speeches only or mainly; and yet who does not rank him as a great American author? an author as truly expounding, and as characteristically exemplifying, in a pure, genuine, and harmonious English style, the mind, thought, point of view...
