

Definition of Grinding. Generally, the term grinding is used to designate the operation of reducing a substance to a powder by friction or trituration. It is also used to designate the act of sharpening tools. In the present section, it will be understood to mean the polishing, finishing, or sharpening of tools or metal parts (mostly hardened steel) by means of revolving wheels composed of or covered with angular grains of some abrading material that is harder than the substance to be cut. The grinding process is characterized by the fact that the material removed is all reduced to a fine powder, and on this account the amount of power necessary to remove a given weight of material by grinding is greater than would be the case with a machine tool that produced larger chips. 2. Grinding Materials. - All grinding is done by the angular grains of some hard substance that are held in place while doing the grinding by being bedded in a softer substance, or that are so cemented or united together as to form a wheel or a rectangular mass. Most grinding materials are used in the form of wheels, and may be divided into the two classes, grindstones and grinding wheels the latter including all emery, corundum, and carborundum wheels.
