I think, therefore, that these magnitudes are worthy of very considerable confidence. In the supplementary table here presented, the fourth column contains the magnitude already given in the Uranometria Nova Oxoniensis, the second is the concluded magnitude derived from all the extinctions of the several nights of observation. It is, I think, highly satisfactory to find that no important corrections are to be made to the original determinations.
